***<sup>9</sup> 'As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love.***

***<sup>10</sup> If you keep my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commands and remain in his love. <sup>11</sup> I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete. <sup>12</sup> My command is this: love each other as I have loved you. <sup>13</sup> Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends. <sup>14</sup> You are my friends if you do what I command. <sup>15</sup> I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you. <sup>16</sup> You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit – fruit that will last – and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you. <sup>17</sup> This is my command: love each other.***

**OUR FELLOWSHIP MATTERS**

**Matters for prayer:**

- ***Health: There are several within the fellowship who have undergone recent procedures. Some of which are exploratory. Please pray that they will know God's peace as they await results, and that His healing hand will be upon them.***  
(John 14 v27 - Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.)  
(Jeremiah 30 v17 - But I will restore you to health and heal your wounds," declares the Lord,)
- ***The believer to be baptised – for protection over him and his family as he prepares for, and following, his believer's baptism;***  
(2 Thes 3 v3: But the Lord is faithful. He will establish you and guard you against the evil one.)
- ***Outreach –Please pray for all involved in the planned outreach events.***  
(Matt 28 v19-20 "19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you.".)  
(Gal 6:9 - Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.)
- ***The Chapel leadership team – that they receive help where it is needed;***  
(Hebrews 13: 20-21 - "Now may the God of peace, equip you with everything good for doing his will,")
