We are really encouraged that prisoners are asking for the written studies, which go into prisons once a fortnight. A couple of the men we have had contact with are using them together for further study and have asked for more study material. Please continue to pray for these men as they read and study God's Word. Another encouragement is that we have more prisoners asking for someone to write to. This provides a lovely opportunity for people to share the gospel in an informal way and show them some Christian compassion.

OUR FELLOWSHIP MATTERS

“I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayer, intercessions and thanksgiving be made for all people”

1 Timothy 2: 1

Matters for prayer:

- **New life** – give thanks for new life, and the safe arrival of new grandchildren.
(*Psalm 139:13-14* ¹³ For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb.¹⁴ I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well.)
- **The fellowship** – for all those within Storrington Chapel who are struggling with health issues and troubles. Please pray that our Lord will swiftly ease their pain.
(*2 Cor 1:3-4* - Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, ⁴ who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves receive from God.)
- **Outreach and evangelism** – Please pray for the Lord's guidance and direction for outreach work and bringing the Word to those outside the Chapel fellowship.
(*Col 4: 5-6* - Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity. ⁶ Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone.)
- **5 Loaves Café** – Please pray that there will be sufficient helpers/bakers for this month as a number of helpers who are not available.
(*Phil 2: 13* - for it is God who works in you to will and to act in order to fulfil his good purpose.)
- **The deacons and wives** – that they will receive resources, and help where it is needed, to give them the time to be able to carry out the Lord's work that they need time to do;
(*Hebrews 13: 20-21* - “Now may the God of peace, equip you with everything good for doing his will, “)
