OUR FELLOWSHIP MATTERS

“I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayer, intercessions and thanksgiving be made for all people” 1 Timothy 2: 1

Matters for prayer:

- ***The fellowship – for all those who are looking for a direction in their lives:***
(Isaiah 30 v21 ²¹ Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, ‘This is the way; walk in it.’)
For those struggling with health, in relationships or with financial issues:
(Isaiah 41 v10 - So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.)
- ***Outreach and evangelism – Pray for the Lord’s guidance and direction for in the planned outreach work over the coming months, so that we may bring the Word to those outside the Chapel fellowship.***
(Col 4: 5-6 - Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity. ⁶ Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone.)
- ***5 Loaves Café – Please pray for continued blessing on the café and those that run it, as it reopens on 6th September, and for all those who visit it as they return.***
(Gal 6:9 - Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.)
- ***The deacons and wives – that they will receive resources and help where it is needed, to give them the time to be able to carry out the Lord’s work that they are being guided to do;***
(Hebrews 13: 20-21 - “Now may the God of peace, equip you with everything good for doing his will, “)
