What does that verse mean to you? Does it bring to mind those photos of smiling families from the east-end of London, spending their summer holidays in Kent harvesting the hops? Or machines in fields collecting cauliflowers? Or vast fields of grain with combine-harvesters cutting the crops?

Whilst that imagery may be sort of right, the harvest being talked about here is very different – it's the souls of those yet to accept Jesus into their lives as their personal Saviour, and we are **all**, as believers, instructed by Jesus to be workers in the field:

"¹⁹ Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you." Matthew 28: 19-20

OUR FELLOWSHIP MATTERS

"I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayer, intercessions and thanksgiving be made for all people" 1 Timothy 2: 1

Matters for prayer:

- ***The fellowship – please pray for all those who are struggling with health or financial issues, in relationships, or are looking for direction in their lives:***
(Isaiah 30 v21 ²¹ Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, 'This is the way; walk in it.')
- ***3-2-1 – Pray that Jo and Liz will receive offers of help from others within the fellowship for the door-to-door evangelising and distributing invites to this, and other planned outreach events.***
(Matt 28 v19-20 *"¹⁹ Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you."*).
- ***5 Loaves Café – Give thanks for the continued blessings on the café, those that run it, and who visit it.***
(Gal 6:9 - Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.)
- ***The deacons and wives – that they will receive resources and help where it is actually needed;***
(Hebrews 13: 20-21 - "Now may the God of peace, equip you with everything good for doing his will, ")
